The focus of our communication today is *Face Coverings*.

Q: **What is a Face Covering?**

'A face covering is a material you wear that covers the nose and mouth.'

Q: **Why do we need to wear face coverings?**

'Wearing a face covering reduces the spread of coronavirus in the community. It helps to reduce the spread of respiratory droplets from people infected with coronavirus. This helps to stop people who are not aware they have the virus from spreading.'

Over the past weeks, we have all had to adapt to wearing face coverings and we do understand that this has not been easy for everyone. We do know that face coverings can feel uncomfortable and hot at times and can be especially challenging for example, for those of us who wear glasses. - ✓ Practice safe removal and disposing of single use masks, where appropriate.
